MARK 1:16-20, 4:35-41, 6:34-44, 16:20

- The disciples moved from unconscious incompetence to unconscious competence
- Jesus’ training framework was not linear – but it was developmental and intentional

KEY IDEAS

1. Freedom to make mistakes is important for growth
2. Delicate practice (think: next steps) with truthful review develops conscious competence
3. Think: INFORMATION/IMITATION and CATALYST/COACH squares
